Sermon Title: Truly Clean
Scripture: Mark 7:1–23

This week, Pastor David shared a message from the Gospel of Mark about how our hearts, not our outward actions, measure the authenticity of our relationship with God.

- In verse 5, the Pharisees saw impure hands as an indication of an impure heart. How did Jesus show the hypocrisy in their thinking? (vv. 6–8; vv. 18–23).
- Jesus taught that our hearts are broken and tainted by sin. Is that supported by our current culture?
   Explain.
- Pastor David shared that there is hope for our broken hearts and used the example of a heart transplant to describe how Jesus can fix our broken hearts. Have you received the salvation that Jesus offers?
- As a recipient of the new heart that Jesus offers, how are you motivated by gratitude? What can you
  do this week to share that gratitude with others?
