AfterThoughts May 2, 2021 Sermon Title: The Man With No Name Scripture: Luke 16:19–31

This week, Dr. John Cantelow, Senior Pastor of Sixth Avenue Baptist Church, shared a message from the Gospel of Luke.

Going Deeper:

- 1. Jesus used this parable to teach about the dangers of prioritizing wealth, success, and notoriety over the needs of others. How did the rich man show what his priorities were?
- 2. Dr. Cantelow said that, just like Abraham interceded for Lazarus, Jesus intercedes for you and me. How are you encouraged by knowing that Jesus speaks to the Father on your behalf?
- 3. Think about someone you know who is experiencing difficulties without support right now. What keeps you from helping them? What can you do to put yourself in a position to meet their needs in what might be their worst moments?
- 4. While your name might be prominent now, Dr. Cantelow shared that the most important thing is that your name is written in Heaven. Is your name written in Heaven? If not, what is keeping you from becoming a follower of Jesus today?
