Going Deeper:

- The call to discipleship is a call to follow Jesus so closely that we begin to talk the way He talked, to think the way He thought, and to walk the way He walked. We are called to be "followers" not "fans." How have you settled for just being a "fan" of Jesus?
- If you are a disciple of Jesus, prayer is the oxygen you breathe for your spiritual life. In what way(s) do you make prayer a priority in your daily life?
- Pastor David shared that disciples of Jesus see the commands in the Bible as invitations from their Savior to experience the joy of active submission to Him. Does this description fit the way you experience obeying God's word? If not, what do you need to change in your daily routine to conform to this description?
- Pastor David shared the CLOSER acronym to guide you in your discipleship journey.
 What area(s) of the acronym do you need to focus on this week? How will you prioritize those areas?
