- How might God use YOU as "bread" for someone else during 2019? Will you allow Him to use you?

**In your time with God this week,**

1. Thank God for being I AM and for His constant provision of your every need.
2. Ask God to remind you of all the ways He has provided what you need, even when it wasn't what you wanted or expected.
3. Commit to be available for whatever God would have you do and however He would have you work in the lives of others in 2019.
