

## June 10, 2018 Wisdom For Living James 3:13-18

This week, Pastor David shared about the view of wisdom from James. Read and reflect on James 3:13-18 and James 1:5-8 as you answer these questions.

- What is YOUR definition of wisdom? How is wisdom different from knowledge?
- When do you find yourself going to sources OTHER THAN GOD *(friends, family, books, etc.)* for guidance? Why do you go to those sources before going to God?
- According to James 1:6, what attitude are we to have when we ask God for wisdom?
- <u>Watch this clip</u> from the movie, *"Mrs. Doubtfire"*. Pastor David shared, in the same way that Mrs. Doubtfire was trying to live in 2 different worlds, Christians can find themselves doing the same thing holding on to God with one hand and holding on to the world with the other. In what area(s) have you been guilty of being a "double-souled" follower of Christ?

In your time with God this week, <u>repent</u> of any time that you have looked for wisdom in places/people other than Scripture/God. <u>Surrender</u> ALL the areas where you have been "double minded". Finally, <u>commit</u> to asking God for wisdom FIRST.
