Fall Unit 5: God's Son, Jesus, is Born

Bible Verse:"God loved us and sent His Son." 1 John 4:10

God's Word & Me (Bottom Line): I can thank God for sending His Son, Jesus.

Luke 2:8-20





One quiet night, a long time ago, some shepherds were outside taking care of their sheep.

Then the angels left. The shepherds said, "Let's go find this special baby. Let's hurry!"


Steppity-step. The shepherds hurried along the road until they found the stable where Jesus was.




The baby Jesus was lying in a manger where the animals usually ate. Everything was just as the angel had said. The shepherds were so happy to see baby Jesus!
