Bible Phrase: Do not be afraid. Acts 27:24

Scripture Reference: Mark 4:1-2,35-41

Bible Story: What a lot of people! Many people wanted to see Jesus and hear Him teach about God's love. Jesus was standing near the lake. There were so many people that Jesus got into a boat and sat down. Then He talked to the people from the boat. All the people stood by the lake and listened to Jesus.

Later that day, Jesus said to His helpers, "Let's go to the other side of the lake." So Jesus and His helpers sailed in the boat.

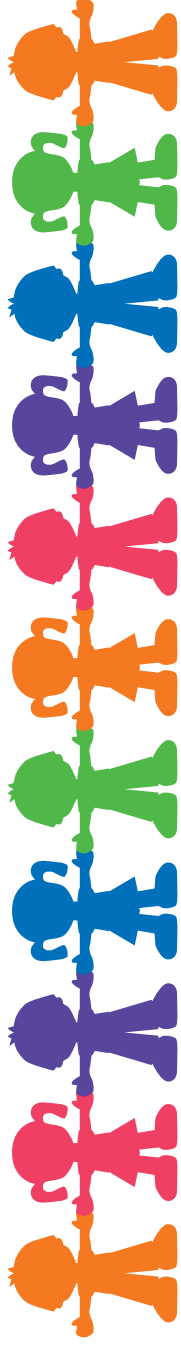
Jesus lay down in the boat to rest. He fell asleep. A storm began! Wind and waves rocked the boat back and forth. Water came over the sides and into the boat. Jesus' helpers were afraid. They woke Jesus up.

Jesus said to His helpers, "Why are you afraid?" Jesus wanted them to know that He would take care of them. Jesus' helpers could hardly believe what they saw. Jesus stopped the storm! Now they knew that Jesus was very special.

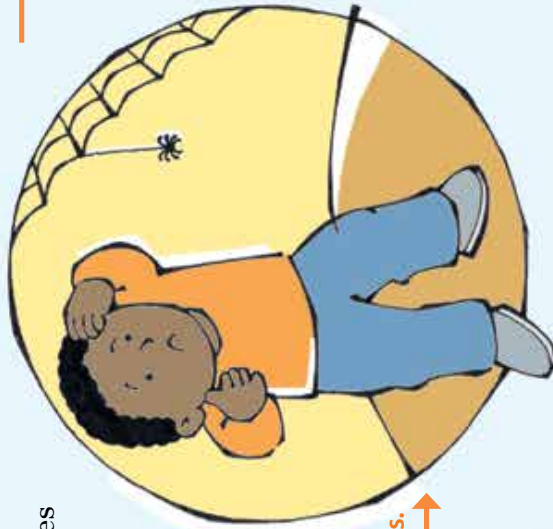

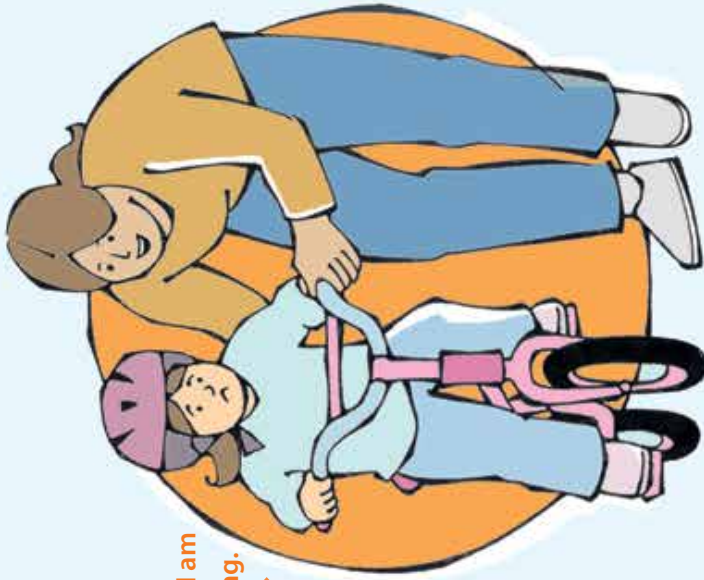


Jesus Helps Me
