One day God said to Abraham, "I have special plans for you and your family. Your wife Sarah will have a baby boy."

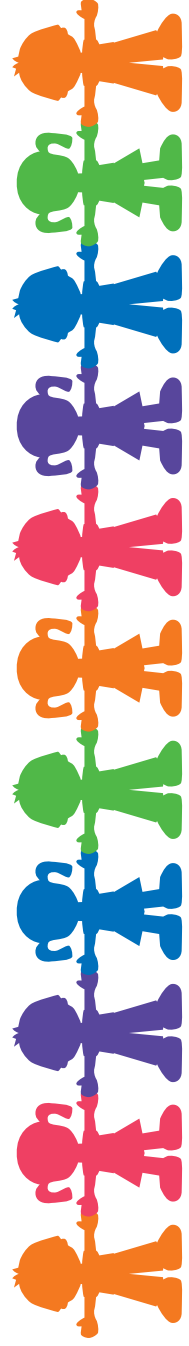
