

God Cared for Noah

Bible Phrase: God cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7

Scripture Reference: Genesis 6:9-10,14-22;
7:1,13-19; 8:1-3,13-20

Bible Story: Noah was a good man who loved God. One day God told Noah to build an ark (a big boat). God told Noah exactly how to build the ark. God told Noah how long the ark should be, how tall it should be, and where to put the door.

God explained to Noah that it was going to rain for many, many days. God said that Noah and his family would be safe in the ark. God also told Noah to take two of every kind of animal with him into the ark. God reminded Noah to take food for his family and the animals.

Noah worked hard to get the ark ready. He did everything God had told him to do. When the ark was finished, Noah and his family and two of every kind of animal got on the ark. God shut the door, and it began to rain.

The rain came down for 40 days and 40 nights, but Noah and his family were safe inside the ark. When the rain finally stopped, Noah waited a long time for all the water to dry up. One day God said, "Come out of the ark. Bring your family and the animals with you."

Noah's family and all of the animals walked out of the ark. Noah thanked God for taking care of him and his family.

Parents:

- Ask your child to make sounds of animals on the ark. Talk about how God took care of the animals and Noah on the ark.
- Comment: "God takes care of you. What are some ways that God takes care of you?" Say the Bible phrase with your child.
