Bible Phrase: God made people. *Genesis 1:27*

Scripture Reference: *Genesis 1:26-31; 2:7,15-24; 4:1-2*

Bible Story: God had made a beautiful, wonderful world!

He made daytime and nighttime. God made water, plants, trees, and grass. God made all kinds of fish, birds, and animals. But God knew there was one thing the world still needed. God knew the world needed people. God said, “People will be more important than the birds, fish, and animals.”

First, God made a man. God named the man Adam. God had made a beautiful garden where Adam could live. God told Adam to take care of the trees and plants in the garden.


God did not want Adam to be alone. So God made a woman to be Adam’s special helper. Adam named the woman Eve.
